1. AYCL presentation

3. 2017 Season set up (T20 using 4 groups, 40-40 and Regular T20)

- We will have 3 tournaments in 2017.
- Short T20 tournament based on 4 groups format.
 - (i) This will be a 5 to 6 weeks' tournament starting on March 5th 2017.
 - (ii) We have 20 teams divided into 4 divisions based on the T20 rankings of 2016.
 - (iii) Top two teams from each group will advance into playoffs.
 - (iv) Playoffs will be Quarter Final, Semi-Final and Final.
 - (v) Top 8 ranking will be decided based on their points, NRR.
 - (vi) There is **NO reserved Day for this tournament**. In case a playoff game doesn't takes place then the higher ranked team will move into the next round.
 - (vii) Playoffs will have Quarter Final (QF), Semi Final (SF) and Final.
 - (viii) QF1 → R1 vs R8
 - (ix) QF2 → R2 vs R7
 - (x) QF3 → R3 vs R6,
 - (xi) QF4 → R4 vs R5
 - ~~(xii) SF1 → Winner of QF1 vs Winner of QF3~~
 - ~~(xiii) SF2 → Winner of QF2 vs Winner of QF4~~
 - The below change was made on 4/5/2017 after request from Fixtures committee and EO approval on the mistake in the typo.
 - (xiv) SF1 → Winner of QF1 vs Winner of QF4
 - (xv) SF2 → Winner of QF2 vs Winner of QF3
 - (xvi) Final → Winner of SF1 vs Winner of SF2

- **40 over tournament** based on 2 divisions format.
 - (i) This tournament has two divisions i.e. Premier and Star.

- (ii) Top 6 teams from 2016 40 over League championship round and Winners of 2016 Star League moves into Premier League.
- (iii) All the remaining teams (12 as of now) will be into the Star Division.
- (iv) This tournament will start from April 16th 2017.

(v) Premier Division Set up is listed below

1. Each team plays against each other as Home and Away Team I.e. each team plays against each other **twice**.
2. Total Round Robin games will be 14
3. No reserve day for Round Robin phase. **No Quarter Final** games.
4. Top 4 teams ranked R1, R2, R3 and R4 moves into the playoffs to play Semi Final (SF).
5. SF1 → R1 vs R3
6. SF2 → R2 vs R4
7. Final → Winner of SF1 vs Winner of SF2
8. We have 2 reserved weekends for playoff games i.e. 1 reserve day for Semi Final games and 1 reserve day for Final. Incase if the playoff game(s) doesn't takes place even on the reserve day then the Higher Ranked team moves forward.
9. Total 16 Sundays + 2 Reserve Sundays.
10. Tentative Dates are April 16th to Aug 27th (18 Weekends after taking out 2 long weekends).

(vi) Star Division Set up is listed below.

1. Each team plays against each other only **once** in Round Robin phase. Total Round Robin games will be 11.
2. No Reserve Day for Round Robin Phase.
3. Top 8 Teams ranked R1 to R8 will move into Play offs.
4. Playoffs will have Quarter Final (QF), Semi Final (SF) and Final.
5. QF1 → R1 vs R8, QF2 → R2 vs R7, QF3 → R3 vs R6, QF4 → R4 vs R5
6. SF1 → Winner of QF1 vs Winner of QF3
7. SF2 → Winner of QF2 vs Winner of QF4
8. Final → Winner of SF1 vs Winner of SF2
9. We will have 2 Reserve days for Playoffs (Semi Final and Final). One reserve day for Semi Final games and One reserve day for Final.
10. **No Reserve day for Quarter Final games.** If Quarter Final games doesn't take place, then Higher seed team moves forward into Semi-Final round.
11. Incase if the playoff game(s) doesn't takes place even on the reserve day then the Higher Ranked team moves forward.
12. Total 14 Sundays + 2 Reserve Sundays.
13. Tentative Dates are April 16th to Aug 20th (16 Weekends after taking our 2 long Weekends).
