## Extra Ordinary BOD-2016 NORTHWEST CRICKET LEAGUE

Date: 11/19/2016

## 1.) PLAYER PROFILES: Proposal Passed with a 9-1 majority. Added to the Playing laws as Law 3.e

Every player (new/old) must update his profile on cricclubs.com/NWCL website with his recent picture and legal Name having clearface identity. A player without a profile picture on the website will not be allowed to participate in a game if an objection is raised to the umpire by any of the opposing team players on the game day.

Exception to the Rule: If the player is listed on the roster, but, does not have his picture updated, the umpire can check his ID and, can allow the player in question to play the game. Umpire must verify the new player's id and make sure the score card is updated correctly after the game and inform the management.

## 2.) FIELDING SUBSTITUTES: Proposal Passed with a $7-3$ majority. Added to the Playing laws under Law 4.d <br> Substitutes can field if they are a part of the team's roster. A player cannot substitute for a team without being on their roster.

## Exception:

1.This rule doesn't apply to all the teams travelling over 75 miles.
2. In case an outside player wants to come and substitute, it's at the discretion of the opposition captain to allow or disallow the outside player.
3.) PLAYOFFS and Reserve Day: (Updated 11/14/2016: change proposed by multiple teams) voted separately for 3a and 3b. Added to the Playing laws under Law 22.d

## 3a passed with 7-2majority and 1 abstained

## 3b passed with 10-0 majority

3.a) If the finals are abandoned due to rain, then the trophy will be shared. If the semifinals are abandoned, then, the higher seeded team goes into the final.
3.b) Playoff for the premier (40 overs) league should be sponsored by NWCL and individual team should not be responsible for paying for the field. Currently it seems like individual team is being penalized economically for performing well during the season. The higher seeded team will be the
home team and can pick the ground of their choice, it's the higher seeded team's responsibility to procure the ground, but, the management pays forit.

## 4.) Removal of Optional Bye-day: proposal passed 10-0: Added to the playing

## laws under Law 22.c

Given the increased teams in the league, it's not feasible for to schedule a bye-day for all the teams. No request for bye weeks will be entertained.

## 5.) Proposal for a change in the-SeasonSchedule:- proposal did not pass

Change the calendar to accommodate all the games including playoffs by Sep 20.
Seasonstarts the $2^{\text {nd }}$ week of April with the premierleague (40overs)
$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ weekend of April to May $22^{\text {nd }}: 7$ weekends give 7 league games for the premierleague-
tune- $1^{\text {st }}$ week to July $2^{\text {nd }}$ week (week afterlong weekend): 5 weeks: T20 Tournament with Playoffs to be playedon the $2^{\text {nd }}$ weekend of July.
July $3^{\text {rd }}$-weekto-September 1st week: remaining 7 games of the premierleague
Sep $2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ week: Playoffs.

## Reasons for Proposal 5:

1.) During Ramadan teams request by weeks, having a $T 20$ gives all the parties an opportunity to schedulegames withouthindering/affecting the League time-table.
2.) Season proceeding into the end of Sep or early October is hampering the prospect of choosing a winner.
3.) With T20 being the current flavor and too many tournaments played during June, July and August across the US, this current structure will give our folks an opportunity to sharpen theirskillsin line with the on-going tournaments and present acase for selections.

Premierleague(40OVER LEAGUE): DivA/B/C/D: 8 teams(Each teamplays otherteam wice, one home andoneaway
NOTE:
A. If the numberofteamsin $D i v \mathrm{D}=4$, then we shall merge thoseteams with DivC (to make it $8+$ 4) and Schedule 11 gamespereach teamin Div C with a reducedteam registrationfee-
B. If Div D has less than \& teams, then, eachteam will playotherstwice (one home andone away) and the team registration fee will be reduced accordingly.

## Opinions Gathered:

1.) Don't change the currentset-up-
2.) Use the long weekends too tocomplete the games before the rainsinterrupt the season.
3.) Reduce the numberof games for 40 -overs to accommodate the sche dule and playoffs without being disrupted by the rains. This suggestion has the following challenges:
a) Notall teamsgetequal home and awaygames.
b) During the season, oneteamendsupincurring highercostscompared to the other, due to the homegameschedule.
c) Management cannot guarantee that alternate years the schedules will change to accommodate home and away gamesequally.

## 6.) Peduce the-40-versformat to-30-0versi-Proposal did not pass

Play 2 gamesper day during the months of May, June, July (Typically 5:45AMsunrise-8:30PM-sunset or later) to avoidextending the gamesintoSept/Oct. Gamescanstart as earlyas 8AM -1:30PM; 2PM 7:30PM (evenif we play for 2:30 minsperteam witha-5 min per overrate (currentlywe plantoplay for 4 mins per over) we will be done ahead of the scheduled sunset)

Pros: Scheduling and ground availability being an issue, this reducedover will help with planning better and we might be able to add another T20 league. Additionally, players get more time back to spend with family and avoid sleeping on the couch for the rest of the week. This will help with game ballsissue as well as the ball will bejust 30 overs and will not takealot of beating. Number of games need not be reduced, just the teams mustadjust playing early andlaterin the day. Cons:-Overs are reducedto 30 from-40, lessoverstoplay.:) Scheduling will be tricky; however, this will be a onetime effort and the element of weathercoming into playspecifically during the playoffs will not be anissue anymore.

Exception: Only months of July and August.

## 7.) Financial Grants: proposal passed with a 10-0 majority: Added to the By-

## Laws as Law 23.

Financial grants for any ground repairs or otherwise shall not be entertained unless actual receipts are produced for the work done. There is a limit of $\$ 1000$ per club per 3 years. All financial grants to be approved by BOD.

## 8.)Game-Abandenment:-Proposal withdrawn.

No-game can be abandoned by one team calling the umpire and letting him know that game is not playable because of the weathercondition or some other external factors. If fieldis not playable and/or shut down by the park authorities, then, the NWVL management needs to be informed 24 hour in advance and they will take appropriate action. Game canonly be abandonedon the game day by umpire and that tooif umpire is present at the field.

## 9.) Points-Systemre-structuring:-Proposal did not pass

Need to adapt the ICC points system. Remove the bonus point systemand allow the teamstocompetebasedon wins and loses rather than bonus points. The points will be awarded as suggested below:

A wingives 10 points (4 points)

## Alossis 0 points

An abandonedgame is 0 points foreach team.
A forfeited game is considered a win for the opposition.
Fieis 5 points ach.
Bonus points: 1 for battingand 1 for bowling
bonus point for batting: If the innings run-rate isat/over6 RPO then the team will get 1 batting bonus pointirrespective of winorloss.
bonus point for bowling:Ifateam dismisses all the opposition batsmen then theyget 1 bowling point irrespective of win orloss.

## 10.) Roster Limits: fadeded $11 / 4 / 2016+$ proposal did not pass.

Every team roster can onlyadd 18 playersinany giventournament. No player can play/substitute in a game withoutbeinglisted on the roster. Once the rosteris filled with 18 names, the teamcannot make any changes unless they inform the NWCL Management prior to the change. If a player is being removed from a roster, he cannot participate for the same team for the remainder of the tournament.

## 11.) Umpire-Change (Added 11/11/2016) Submitted by Spartans-CC: proposal withdrawn

Umpire cannot be changed without notice, at least 2 days informing both team captains. Often the Umpiring assignments are being swapped within the teams/clubs based on their respective player's availability, although thisis ok, this change must be informed to both the captains priorto the game day.

## 12.) Under 19 Players: (Added 11/14/2016: Submitted by multiple teams)Contingent upon the schedule

a) Under 19 players should be allowed to play in the club without being tied to a roster. They should be allowed to play with different teams with in the club if they do not play more than the maximum amount of games (maximum games per team is 14) played by an individual team. This will give youngster an opportunity to play more games rather than just being on standby for one team.
b) The U19 player can change club during anytime of the season before Aug31.
c) To encourage U-19 participation, NWCL should offer a fee reduction to teams, who, have U19 folks play for them for at least $50 \%$ of the games. The reduction in fee will be a BOD decision at the beginning of the season.

## 13.) Team Promotions: Added 11/14/2016: Proposed by Spartans CC

Rules for moving up the divisions should be reconsidered, league champs (top team in table after league) and division finalist (who wins final if not top team in table after league, runner up team from final if top team from league wins.). That way teams playing in Semis has chance to go to next Div. Good for competition.
