



## 2-day-Test Match-Rules

- ❖ When : Sep 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
- ❖ Time: 10 AM to 5:00 PM
- ❖ Umpires :1
- ❖ Jerseys:Whites (red ball)
- ❖ Players Fee: \$50 ( for-2Days)
- ❖ Overs Per Day: 70 -Total 140 Overs
- ❖ Overs Per Session :Min 25,Maximum 29.
- ❖ Innings Break:10 Minutes
- ❖ Lunch Break -45 minutes
- ❖ Tea Break-15 minutes

**Day 1 and Day 2 Respectively:**

**Morning Session :**

10 AM -12 :00 PM (Min 25 Overs to be Bowled with break for 5 min after 1 hour of play)-

**Drinks Break:**

After 13 overs:10 minutes

**Lunch Break :**

12:00 to 12:45 PM ( Lunch will be provided by NTCL Org.Committee)

**Post Lunch Session:**

12:45 PM -2:45 PM ( Min 25 Overs to be Bowled with break for 5 min after 1 hour of play)

**Tea/Snacks Break :**

2:45 PM to 3:00 PM

**Post-Tea Session:**

3:00 PM TO 5:00 PM ( Bowled until 70 overs per day quota is finished) -Approx. 20 overs in final session

Important Rules ( Otherwise, all ICC rules applies)

- ✓ Game ends in a draw if no result until last ball of day 2.
- ✓ Two- Innings per team ( Unless a follow-on)
- ✓ In a two-innings match of 2-day game, the side which bats first and leads by at 100 runs in a 2-day match; shall have the option of requiring the other side to follow their innings

### **First day's play lost**

1. If no play takes place on the first day of a match of more than one day's duration ICC rule 14.1 shall apply in accordance with the number of days remaining from the start of play. The day on which play first commences shall count as a whole day for this purpose, irrespective of the time at which play starts.

### **2. New ball**

- ✓ A new ball shall be used at the start of each innings.
- ✓ New ball available after every 35 overs

### **THE SCORING:**

- ✓ Scored on cricclubs app and counted as **regular league game**.

### **Pitch:**

- ✓ Match will be played on both sides of the wicket at Lewisburg Cricket Ground

### **INNINGS**

#### **Number of innings**

A match shall be two innings for each side ( No limit on overs)

#### **Alternate innings**

Each side shall take their innings alternately except in the cases provided for in follow-on (The follow-on) or in clause Forfeiture of an innings

#### **Completed innings**

- ✓ A side's innings is to be considered as completed if any of the following applies
- ✓ the side is all out.
- ✓ 1 at the fall of a wicket or the retirement of a batsman, further balls remain to be bowled but no further batsman is available to come in.
- ✓ the captain declares the innings closed.
- ✓ the captain forfeits the innings.

### **Out LBW**

- ✓ The striker is out LBW if all the circumstances set out in clause:
- ✓ The bowler delivers a ball, not being a No ball
- ✓ if it is not intercepted full-pitch, pitches in line between wicket and wicket or on the off side of the striker's
  - wicket
- ✓ the ball not having previously touched his bat, the striker intercepts the ball, either full-pitch or after pitching, with any part of his person
- ✓ the point of impact, even if above the level of the bails,
- ✓ either is between wicket and wicket

- ✓ or if the striker has made no genuine attempt to play the ball with the bat, is
- ✓ between wicket and wicket or outside the line of the off stump.
- ✓ but for the interception, the ball would have hit the wicket.

### **Substitutes and Concussion Replacements**

- ✓ A Substitute is a player who takes the place of a fielder on the field of play but does not replace the player for whom he substitutes on that side's list of nominated players. A substitute's activities are limited to fielding.
- ✓ Concussion Replacement is a player who takes the place of a player who has been replaced in accordance with the process set out in clause 1.2.7, and who for the remainder of the match replaces that player on that side's list of nominated players.
- ✓ 1.2.7 If a player sustains a concussion or suspected concussion as a result of a head or neck injury during the course of the relevant match, a Concussion Replacement may be permitted in the following circumstances: 1.2.7.1 the head or neck injury must have been sustained during play and within the playing area described in clause 1.2.5.2 above; 1.2.7.2 a concussion or suspected concussion must have been formally diagnosed by the Team Medical Representative; 1.2.7.3 the Team Medical Representative or Team Manager shall submit a Concussion Replacement Request to the ICC Match Referee on a standard form, which shall: 1.2.7.3.1 identify the player who has sustained the concussion or suspected concussion; 1.2.7.3.2 specify the incident in which the concussion or suspected concussion was sustained, including the time at which it occurred; 1.2.7.3.3 confirm that, following an examination, the Team Medical Representative believes or suspects that the player has sustained a concussion as a result of the incident specified in 1.2.7.3.2 above; and 1.2.7.3.4 identify the requested Concussion Replacement, who shall be a like-for-like replacement for the player who has sustained the concussion or suspected concussion
