

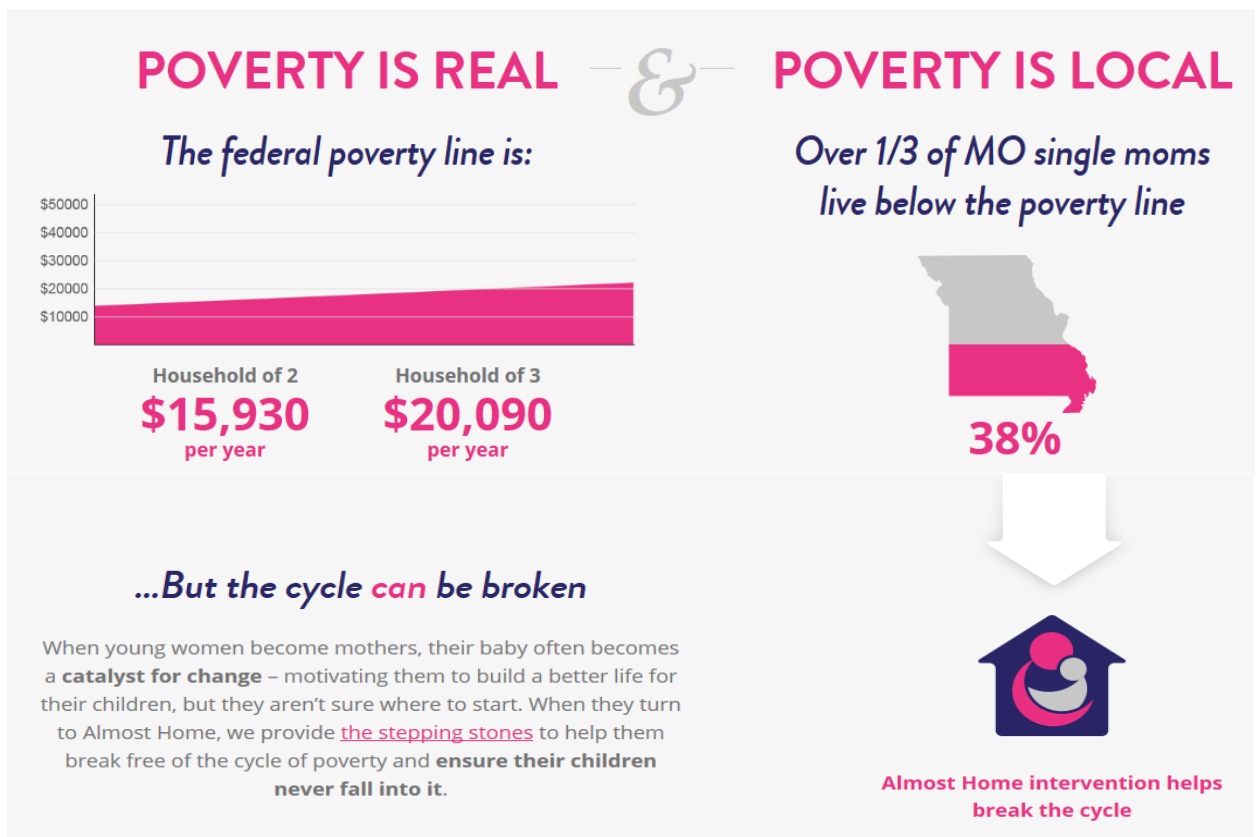


## OFCL Charity Cricket Event – Sponsorship Request

OFCL (O’Fallon Cricket league, [www.ofcl.org](http://www.ofcl.org)) is a non-profit organization that is established in 2009 working towards the true spirit of sportsman ship for the cricket loving community of city of O’Fallon & rest of Missouri. We have over 18+ teams participating in the league with over 300+ people from Citi Group, Enterprise Rent a Car, MasterCard Worldwide, Wells Fargo, Maritz, Scottrade, Monsanto and several other organizations participate.

Outside of the regular tournaments, OFCL has been conducting a charity tournament from 2013 to help the needy, this year the league has identified the following organizations to support from the funds that they generate through the event.

1. **Almost Home**, a local St. Louis Organization provides a continuum of targeted programs that give highly motivated young moms the support and roadmap they need to achieve economic self-sufficiency. Women can begin receiving services at different points of our continuum of services depending on their specific needs. **Almost Home’s** integrated service delivery starts with the Foundation to Success Program which provides up to two years of housing and services for 16-20 year old pregnant or parenting young women and their children. The next level of our service model is the one-year Creating Employment Opportunities Program for 18-28 year old low-income moms. The final level of support is provided through our Alumni Support Program which offers up to 8 years of ongoing support services for any graduate of our FTS or CEO Programs. 2. **Bright Life Foundation (BLF)** is a non-profit organization committed to help and improve the lives of "at risk" children. BLF funds around 280+ kids who are orphans, street children, and those infected with or affected by HIV. The foundation is committed to providing these children a free education of the highest quality, room and board, health care, and counseling services to empower them with tools for a brighter future. 3. **Support education needs for the under privileged students**, this program supports education in Rural India that helps with providing digital classrooms, building reverse Osmosis plant (for clean drinking water) & toilets for schools

While these centers are run by the government, they receive so meager a grant that there is not enough food or a place to sleep or clothes for these babies. With help from several generous and kind hearted people, things are improving.

Statistics for the Centers OFCL supports:

Number of Cradles: Devarkonda Center: 10 cradles and 60 orphan kids

Nalgonda Center: 15 cradles and 60 orphan kids

If more kids are brought in, these babies are turned away due to regulations from the government. OFCL is working with the government to increase the limitation, since the babies being turned away are in danger.

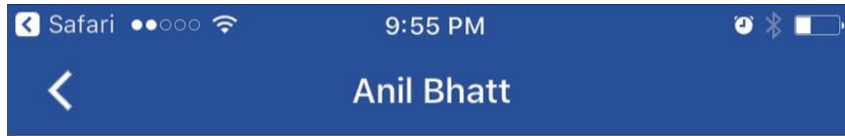
