## CPLKC2019 Spring League - Playoff Rules

## Player Eligibility

1. Player needs to have played minimum 2 games, if teams want to play a player who couldn't play 2 games because of number of washout games, they can request the organizing committee 1 week prior to playoffs game to request a waiver.

## Playoffs scheduling

2 Top 4 teams from each division will play semis
2.1.1 No. 1 to play No. 4
2.1.2 No. 2 to play No.
2.1.3 A1 vs A4 (July $13^{\text {th }} 8$ am @OCG) A2 vs A3 (July $13^{\text {th }} 11: 30$ am @OCG)

B1 vs B4 (July $13^{\text {th }} 3$ pm @OCG) B2 vs B3 (July $14^{\text {th }} 8$ am @OCG)
C1 vs C4 (July $14^{\text {th }} 11: 30$ am @OCG) C2 vs C3 (July $14^{\text {th }} 3 \mathrm{pm}$ @OCG)
2.1.4 PCG will be back up ground in case OCG is unplayable.
2.1.5 Organizers will judge the playing conditions, and if games needs to be canceled because of weather of ground conditions
2.1.6 Organizers reserve the right to move the games in case of bad weather only
2.1.7 All playoffs teams should make themselves available on both days (July $13^{\text {th }}$ and July $14^{\text {th }} 2019$ ), as matches can be moved because of weather reasons.
2.1.8 Playoffs matches if rescheduled in the order of cancelation (or advanced in case of pending weather prediction), however reschedule can be only for weather related reason and no other reason.

3 Winners of semi finals will advance to finals
4 Cup winner and the top team from the league stage will be promoted to the next upper division for the coming tournament. In case both teams are same then the runner up will advance.
5 Bottom 2 teams at league stage are relegated to the lower division for the next tournament.

## Semi Final rules

1. If a Semi-Final is tied, the teams shall compete in a Super Over to determine which team progresses to the Final.
2. If following a tie, weather conditions prevent the Super Over from being completed, or if the match is abandoned or a no result at the end of the reserve day, then the team which proceeds to the Final will be the team that finished in the higher position in the League Stage.

## Final

1. Finals will be conducted on July $20^{\text {th }}$ (Div A 8: am, Div B: 11:30 am, Div C 3:00 pm)
2. July $21^{\text {st }}$ is reserve day and games will be moved only if July $20^{\text {th }}$ game is canceled due to rain.
3. Matches will be rescheduled in order of cancelation
4. Organizers will make final call on moving games (captains wont have a say)
5. In the event of a tied final, the teams shall compete in a Super Over to determine which team is the winner.
6. If following a tie, weather conditions prevent the Super Over from being completed, or if the match is abandoned or a no result at the end of the reserve day, the teams shall be declared joint winners.
