

CPLKC2020 Spring League - Playoff Rules

Player Eligibility

1. Player needs to have played **minimum 2 games**, if teams want to play a player who couldn't play 2 games because of number of washout/abandoned/forfeited (by opponent) games, they can request the organizing committee 1 week prior to playoffs game to request a waiver.

Playoffs Scheduling

2. Top 4 teams from each division will play semis

2.1.1 No. 1 to play No. 4

2.1.2 No. 2 to play No.

2.1.3 Dates are scheduled on the website with reserve dates.

2.1.4 PCG will be back up ground in case OCG is unplayable.

2.1.5 Organizers will judge the playing conditions, and if games need to be canceled because of weather of ground conditions

2.1.6 Organizers reserve the right to move the games in case of bad weather or local Govt. rules based on Covid situation. No other reasons to move the game will be considered.

2.1.7 All playoffs teams should make themselves available on both days (scheduled day and reserve day), as matches can be moved because of weather reasons.

2.1.8 Playoff matches will be rescheduled in the order of cancelation (or advanced in case of pending weather prediction), however reschedule can be only for weather related reason or to follow Govt. mandate reasons only.

3 Winners of semifinals will advance to finals.

4 No relegation/promotion within league divisions will be applied based on the 2020 League Tournaments due to Covid situation and a smaller number of participants.

Semi Final Rules

1. If a Semi-Final is tied, the teams shall compete in a Super Over to determine which team progresses to the Final.
2. After a tie, if weather conditions prevent the Super Over from being completed, or if the match is abandoned or a no result at the end of the reserve day, then the team which proceeds to the Final will be the team that finished in the higher position in the League Stage.

Finals

1. Finals will be conducted as per the schedule on the website.
2. If the reserve day is also cannot be used due to weather, the league will schedule the finals to the following week.
3. Matches will be rescheduled in order of cancelation.
4. Organizers will make final call on moving games (captains don't have a say)
5. In the event of a tied final, the teams shall compete in a Super Over to determine which team is the winner.
6. After a tie, if weather conditions prevent the Super Over from being completed, or if the match is abandoned or a no result at the end of the reserve day, another weekend will be scheduled by the organizers if weather permits. If organizers see there is no viable option with an acceptable weather condition in the foreseeable weather forecast, the teams shall be declared joint winners.
